Social Reforms made by Raja Ram Mohan Roy

Raja Ram Mohan Roy was one of the famous and main social reformer of that time he was very much frustrated from the Sati Pratha (this was an old Hindu tradition in which when the husband of any woman was died and his wife must be burnt with the dead body of her husband, in earlier days it was done by the will of wife but later on the family members of husband pressurised wife to burn with the dead body of her husband).
